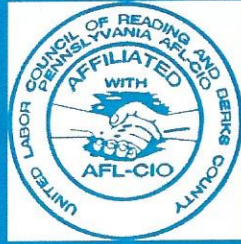

## *United Labor Council of Reading and Berks County* *2020 Scholarship Essay Contest*

October 29th, 2019

We are proud to announce that the United Labor Council of Reading and Berks County will be offering two \$500 scholarships. One scholarship will be offered to an individual that is a graduating senior for continued education in college or trade school, and another scholarship will be offered to an individual currently in college or trade school. All applicants, from a union family, must submit an 1,000 word essay on the topic of Labor and how unions support working families. All applicants must submit their essay via mail to 1251 N Front Street, Suite 1, Reading PA 19601 by **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019**. The envelope will then directly go to the Scholarship Committee made up of 3 members outside of the ULC Board.

The Committee will meet with the ULC board on the 4th day of February, 2020 at the delegates meeting at 7:00pm at 1251 N Front street and announce the scholarship essay winners. Each winner will receive a ticket to our 60th Anniversary Awards and Scholarship Dinner on March 7th, 2020 at the Double Tree by Hilton in Reading, 701 Penn Street, Reading PA 19601. Dinner will begin at 6pm and winners will be announced that evening including receipt of the scholarship. Additional tickets are available for purchase at \$60 per person, and includes dinner and cash bar.
